

# Working with the New ArcGIS Online Map Viewer

## Overview

ArcGIS Online and Portal for ArcGIS have an updated Map Viewer, with a great new interface for creating and sharing maps. This workshop will introduce to you the new interface, help you find all the buttons and tools you are used to, and see what's new. You will learn how to create maps, work with symbology, create labels, run filters, and edit features in the new app. You will also learn to create charts with the new functionality that was not available in Map Viewer Classic.

## Topics Covered

- Creating Web Maps – Understanding how to create web maps in the new map viewer. (Creating a Web Map; Finding and Adding Data)
- Symbols and Editing– Getting familiar with all of the basic necessities for configuring layers. (Display Properties; Editing Features)
- Charts – Analyzing trends in the data using the new chart functionality to create bar charts, line charts, histograms, and scatter plots. (Working with Charts)
